Clubhouse Guidelines

As of July 22, 2020

The following clubhouse guideline updates approved at the Master Board Meeting on July 21, 2020, are noted in **red**. All other guidelines were approved at the Master Board Meeting on June 18, 2020

We remind all residents that if you are feeling ill or are experiencing a runny nose, cough, or fever to not visit the clubhouse until these symptoms pass. We also encourage everyone to follow all of the government and CDC guidelines concerning COVID-19.

Clubhouse Hours of Operation

Clubhouse Hours: Monday - Sunday 7 am to 10 pm

Pool Hours: **7:30 am** - 9:45 pm

Fitness Center Hours: 7:30 am - 9:45 pm

Front Desk Communication

We continue to request residents to schedule an appointment via email or phone to update/purchase an access card or RFID, as well as, to schedule time in the Yoga Room, Tennis Court, or Billiard Room.

Please respect social distancing when approaching the clubhouse staff.

Clubhouse Access

Face coverings such as masks are encouraged when entering the clubhouse.

All residents are required to have their access cards to enter the clubhouse. Each resident will be asked to scan their access card on the black scanners mounted on the wall by the front door. Residents without an access card can email the front desk to purchase a new card. Access will not be permitted without an Access Card.

No guests will be permitted in the clubhouse or pool at this time.

Clubhouse Amenities

The east side of the clubhouse will be closed to all residents. This includes the Library, Billiard Room, Bellissima Room, Campeon Room, and the patio adjacent to the Campeon Room.

Coffee and Tea Service will not be available.

The Atrium and Library will have limited seating

Yoga Room

Email front desk to schedule time in the Yoga Room as usual

Tennis Court

Email front desk to reserve time on the Tennis Court

Obtain key from the front desk as usual (*front desk will disinfect keys in between use*)
Residents must use their own equipment (*regularly provided equipment will not be available*)

Fitness Center

10 people limit with social distancing

1 Hour limit due to the number of occupancies

No guests at this time

To utilize the Fitness Center select a fitness tag from the sign located in the atrium. When all tags are in use the Fitness Center is at capacity. When you are finished in the area return your tag to the front desk. The front desk staff will disinfect the tags and return them to the sign. *Tags are first come, first serve. Tags cannot be reserved, 1 tag per resident.*

Pool

50 people limit

Food and beverages are permitted.

Reminder: glass containers or breakable objects of any kind are not permitted anywhere on the pool deck. Items in non-glass, non-breakable, non-spill containers may be consumed in areas adjacent to the pool and spa edge.

Spa

4 people limit with social distancing

Bellissima Room

Can be used for vendor presentations or meetings with Lawyers if pre-approved by the Master Board of Directors

Bocce Ball

Equipment available at the front desk of the clubhouse

Putting Green

Residents must use their own equipment (*regularly provided equipment will not be available*)
